1.) Pick a Location Busy restaurant, church, school, business, vet office, etc. Use your own tree or we can provide the tree. Many businesses already have a tree, so just ask! When you have your location, let us know and we will post it on our social media.

2.) Prepare the Ornaments Our Instruction sheet will provide you with all the details.

3.) Post Pictures Weekly starting November 25

4.) After the Holidays Remove the tree and any ornaments that remain. All trees need to be removed no later than January 3.
